## TOWN & POORS CHARITY FIELD MINUTES of the meeting on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023 (following the Parish Council meeting)

- 1. Apologies for Absence- R Johnson (RJ). Cllr W Burcham (WB-Vice Chair) has now resigned.
- 2. To approve Minutes of the Charity Meeting on 16th February 2023- Cllr SJR proposed signing and approval of the minutes as a true record of the meeting, seconded by Cllr SP and carried unanimously.
- 3. Matters Arising- none.
- 4. Finance:
  - 4.1 <u>Charity accounts report:</u> Balance at 31st December 2022 £2312.11 -noted
  - 4.2 <u>Expenditure for approval 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023</u>: Money to be transferred back to the main Spaldwick Parish Council account for payments made from there while access to the Town and Poors account was blocked by Barclays:
    - 4.2.1 £108 reimbursement paid to Cllr W Burcham for Queen's Green Canopy plaque on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2022.
    - 4.2.2 £87.17 WAVE bill paid on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2022.
    - 4.2.3 £25.00 beekeeping fee reimbursement paid on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022.
    - 4.2.4 £150.00 R. Johnson Christmas payments reimbursement paid on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022.
    - 4.2.5 £220.75 WAVE bill paid on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2023.
    - None of the above transfers can be made given that WB has resigned and Cllr SFdS's access is blocked; payments deferred pending a meeting with Barclays.
  - 4.3 To consider quotations and approve a contractor for grassing the remainder of the field- Cllr SFdS will take over the task of looking for contractors.
- Update regarding the theft of the allotment gates and the insurance claim- The like-for-like replacement has been approved by the Parish Council insurers; welding the gates into place and marking the gates to be investigated.
- 6. Update regarding the allotment site, Allotment Association and allotment usage- Clerk confirmed the allotment rent invoices will be issued imminently.
- 7. To discuss allotment rent for the year 2024-2025- Following discussions, Cllr JO'D proposed the annual rent be raised from £25 to £30 from April 2024; this was seconded by Cllr SP and carried unanimously.
- 8. To consider a request from the Allotment Association for the Parish Council to purchase an outdoor, solar-powered CCTV camera at a cost of approximately £100 which would be placed on plot two's shed, facing the gate- Following discussions the Clerk was asked to request specific details regarding the range of the proposed camera so that further consideration could be given to the proposal.
